

Inclusive Gathering Birmingham Kids Club – Childcare Leader

Volunteer Role Outline

Background information We want to provide a simple, safe, fun and joyful kids activity in a separate room during our IGB worship gathering on the 1st Sunday of each month. The goal of this is to give the kids a positive experience of being at church, while also freeing up parents and carers to engage in worship without their children present.

Volunteer Role Title:	IGB Childcare Leader
Location:	Small Meeting Room - Ibis Hotel – Arcadian - Birmingham
Responsible to:	Volunteer will be under the supervision of Danielle Wilson (Pastor of Inclusive Gathering Birmingham) and responsible to IGB's Core LeadershipTeam
Hours per week: small amount of mid week c	On a rota basis, Sunday afternoons every few months with a ordination and preparation.

Key volunteer activities

- Making yourself available every few months by signing up via a childcare rota.
- Coordinating with your co-leader prior to designated sessions.
- Attending short planning meetings with other leaders via zoom 2-4 times annually (as needed)
- Completing Core Skills training if required.
- Preparing your activity(ies) and organising materials and equipment; A basic box of toys and materials is provided.
- Setting up (or helping to set up) the venue;
- Develop good working relationships with families, children and young people attending ;
- Leading or supporting the activity(ies), encouraging active participation of all;
- Nurturing children's faith
- Clearing up afterwards;
- Using reflective practice share with the pastor your feedback and reflects on how the session went/ improvements for the future



We are looking for people who have the following skills and attributes:

- Willingness to adhere to and celebrate the vision and values of IGB through our Kids Club, especially reflecting our inclusive and affirming nature in activities, language and practice.
- Awareness of and commitment to the participation of children and young people in the life of the church.
- Ability to organise yourself in order to manage your workload efficiently
- Ability to establish positive and productive relationships with children and young people
- Ability to recognise and develop the gifts of others and foster an environment of participation of children and young people
- Willingness to undertake safeguarding training as needed, ie Creating Safer Space- Foundation Module and Core Skills for children's Workers and events or training that inform and equip your ministry.
- Ability to self motivate and work in a team

Criminal record check

The volunteer will need a satisfactory criminal record clearance certificate. Volunteers will be asked to provide all relevant documents for these checks. The cost of the check will be met by the Church.

Level of commitment:

We are seeking volunteers who can form part of a Rota on a team of volunteers – typically, this will require being available to staff the kids club for a 90 min session ever few months.

Training and support provided:

• Volunteers are supported before, during and after the sessions by a supervisor.

• Volunteers will be given a short induction to childcare and safeguarding at IGB by a member of IGB's core leadership team.

• Volunteers must familiarise themselves with IGB's safeguarding policy and may be asked to attend relevant safeguarding training as needed (Advanced Safeguarding Training or equivalent is suggested).

Supervisor:

Volunteers will be supervised by the pastor and/ or safeguarding officer.
